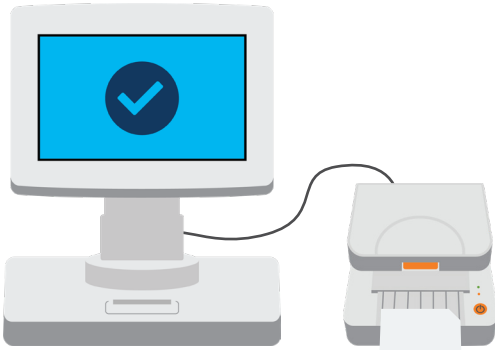

The poll worker uses ExpressPoll or another pollbook solution to identify the voter's correct ballot style.



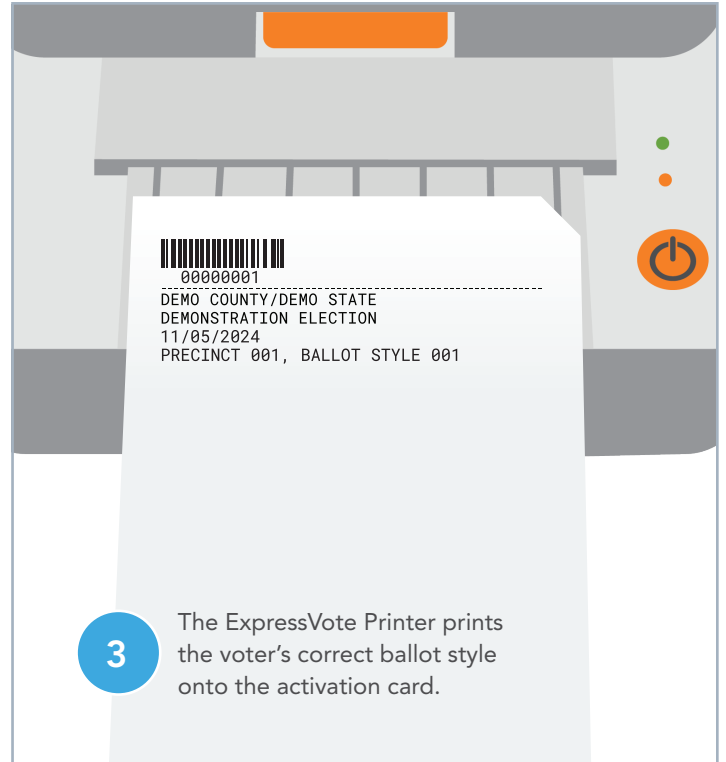

The poll worker inserts a blank activation card into the ExpressVote printer.



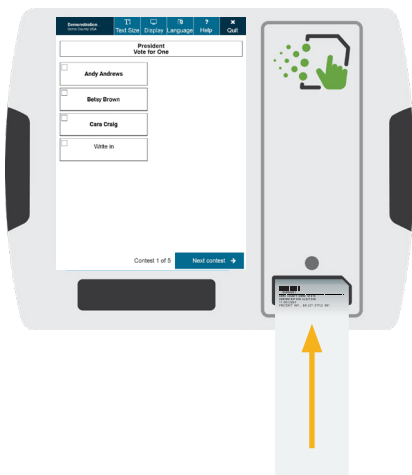
